OVERVIEW

Angel served as the 37th Mayor of Providence, Rhode Island, from 2011 to 2015. As mayor, he led a city government with 5700 employees and a budget of \$678 million and is credited with saving the city from the brink of bankruptcy. Under his leadership, Providence was recognized with the All-America City Award from the National Civic League, was the recipient of a \$3 million award from the Carnegie Foundation to create innovative high schools and received the City Livability Award at the U.S. Conference of Mayors. In addition, Common Cause Rhode Island honored Angel with their Excellence in Public Service Award for his service as Mayor.

Angel serves as an adjunct professor for Providence College.
