BEST CITY EVENT

WaterFire is an award-winning installation of [more than 80] bonfires along the city's downtown rivers. During the spring, summer and fall, bonfires are lit in large iron pans in the center of the rivers and kept burning throughout the evening as visitors stroll along the brick riverside walkways while listening to music, sampling local food and watching street performers.
